

Registration for mother tongue teaching in primary school

This form should be submitted to your child's school.

Excerpt from the Education Act:

Chapter 10. 7§ A student who has a guardian with a mother tongue other than Swedish shall be offered mother tongue teaching in this language if

- 1. The language is the student's daily language of interaction in the home, and
- 2. The student has basic knowledge of the language.

Mother tongue teaching in a national minority language (Finnish, Yiddish, meänkieli, Romani Chib and Sami) must be offered even if the student lacks basic knowledge of the language and/or if the language is not the student's daily language of contact at home.
