



General rules for pitches at Mårtenstorget, Clemenstorget, Fäladstorget and Södra Esplanaden in Lund

Pitches are available at Mårtenstorget, Clemenstorget and Fäladstorget in Lund from Monday until Saturday (closed on general holidays).

Pitches at the flea market on Södra Esplanaden are only available on Saturdays. The flea market is closed on general holidays. For mandatory pre-booking and payment for the flea market, single or double pitch area: www.lund.se/bokaloppis.

OPENING HOURS

Pitches may not be occupied before 06.30. Selling may continue up until 14:00 – or 16.00 depending on which part of the square is used - at Mårtenstorget and up until 17.00 at the other town squares. The pitch area must be cleared at closing time.

PITCH AREA

Temporary, daily, pitch areas are distributed in the order of arriving traders. More permanent pitch areas can be rented (per month/year) at Mårtenstorget. For rental, contact Tekniska Förvaltningen, City of Lund, for more information: tekniska.forvaltningen@lund.se

The most common pitch area measures 4,0 x 4,0 meters. The pitch area may not be extended in any direction. Pitch holders must rectify any breach of the above rule at the request of the Market Officer. For pitch areas and fees, view downloadable document (Torgtaxa) from: www.lund.se/torghandel

ACCESSIBILITY

The flea market must be accessible to the public and must give a positive impression. The thoroughfares between the pitches must therefore remain easily accessible to all parties.

- It is forbidden to store or place items outside your own hired pitch.



- It is forbidden to park cars in the market area. Parking in the market area will result in a fine. Exceptions can be made when the outdoor temperature is 2 degrees Celsius or lower (no exceptions at Södra Esplanaden)

- Cars and trailers may be parked in conjunction with permanent (rented) pitch areas at Mårtenstorget from October 15th until April 15th.

PITCH FEES

Pitch fees are fixed, regardless of sales, visitor numbers, weather conditions, etc.

The City of Lund will not refund pitch fees if the trader fails to use the pitch, regardless of the reason for this. Pitch fees must be paid, and traders must be able to produce a receipt to confirm this at the request of the Market Officer. If pitch fees have not been paid, the pitch may be offered to another trader.

Note: The fee for pitches at Södra Esplanaden must be paid for digitally in advance, on www.lund.se/bokaloppis. The receipt, i.e your e-mail or sms-confirmation, must be available to the Market Officer at request. The confirmation also includes the number of your pitch area, corresponding to number plates on the ground.

PRODUCTS

The selling of food stuffs must adhere to the National Food Act. For questions regarding the selling of food (permissions may be required in some cases) please contact the City of Lund's Environmental administration at 046-35 52 61 or via e-mail: miljoforvaltningen@lund.se

The flea market on Södra Esplanaden is for second-hand goods only. However, certain items may not be sold due to lack of space, danger to others or Swedish laws:

- It is forbidden to sell new factory-made goods, plants and foodstuffs.
- It is forbidden to sell explosives, sprays, war toys, pyrotechnic goods or other items which the Market Officer deems to be inappropriate.
- It is forbidden to market, distribute or sell tobacco products or narcotic, pornographic or political materials.
- It is forbidden to sell lottery tickets.



If goods sold do not meet the above conditions, the pitch owner must remove the products in question at the request of the Market Officer.

LIABILITY

The city of Lund cannot be held liable for pitch holders' equipment and products, or for damage, theft, etc. The pitch holder is responsible for any damage or injuries sustained by third parties as a result of negligence on the part of the pitch holder.

WASTE

Containers are available for pitch holders' use. Pitch holders have an obligation to ensure that nothing is left in the marketplace after the flea market closes.

THE SPECIFIC TAX CONTROL ACT

According to the Swedish Act on Specific Tax Control for Market Trading, etc. (1998:514), the City of Lund is required to keep records of each trader's name, civic registration number, address, telephone number and any company registration number.

These details should be provided on a special form given to each trader by the Market Officer. These details will be archived by the City of Lund, and will not be recorded in any database. Bring a form of identification.

The Market Officer is entitled to evict any trader who refuses to assist in complying with this law. Fees paid will not be refunded.
